JUDGMENT AND PROBATION COMMITMENT ORDER

PLEA GUILTY, and the court being satisfied that there is a factual basis for the plea, NOLO CONTENDERE, NOT GUILTY

FINDING & JUDGMENT There being a finding/verdict of GUILTY. Defendant has been convicted as charged of the offense(s) of

Failure to register for selective service, Title 50 USC, §§ 453 & 462(a).

SENTENCE OR PROBATION ORDER The court asked whether defendant had anything to say why judgment should not be pronounced. Because no sufficient cause to the contrary was shown, or appeared to the court, the court adjudged the defendant guilty as charged and convicted and ordered that: The defendant is hereby committed to the custody of the Attorney General or his authorized representative for a period of

Six months imprisonment, sentence is suspended.

Two years probation.

Special conditions:

1. The defendant is to perform one thousand hours of public service in a program approved of by the Prob. Dept. and this Court.

2. The Prob. Dept. shall file progress reports every six months.

3. The defendant shall appear for reviews when required by this Court. In addition to the special conditions of probation imposed above, it is hereby ordered that the general conditions of probation set out on the reverse side of this judgment be imposed. The Court may change the conditions of probation, reduce or extend the period of probation, and at any time during the probation period or within a maximum probation period of five years permitted by law, may issue a warrant and revoke probation for a violation occurring during the probation period.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF PROBATION COMMITMENT RECOMMENDATION The court orders commitment to the custody of the Attorney General and recommends,

It is ordered that the Clerk deliver a certified copy of this judgment and commitment to the U.S. Marshal or other qualified officer.
