COMES NOW JAMES W. O'HARA, CHIEF U.S. PROBATION OFFICER OF THE COURT presenting an official report upon the conduct and attitude of probationer Edward J. Hasbrouck who was placed on probation by the Honorable David S. Nelson sitting in the court at Boston, MA, on the 14th day of January 1983 who fixed the period of probation supervision at two (2) years, and imposed the general terms and conditions of probation theretofore adopted by the court and also imposed special conditions and terms as follows: Six (6) months imprisonment, sentence is suspended; two (2) years probation with the following Special Conditions:

- (1) The defendant is to perform 1000 hours of voluntary public service in a program approved by the Probation Department and the Court.
- (2) The Probation Department shall file progress reports every six months.
- (3) The defendant shall appear for reviews when required by this Court.
